

# Senior Student Leader – Description

## MEMPHIS STUDENT MINISTRY MISSION:

Memphis Student Ministry exists in order to make and equip disciples of this generation. Our purpose is to engage students relationally so that they will **DISCOVER** who God is, **CONNECT** in Community, **GROW** in their faith, **LOVE** with purpose, and **SEEK** out lost students. Our focus is for students entering into middle school and leaving home after graduation knowing the truth of **WHO** they are and **WHOSE** they are, as fully-committed followers of Jesus.

## Expectations

- **Be an Example** – Live out your faith with integrity on and off church property.
- **Be Present** – Show up on time, ready to serve and engage each Saturday night.
- **Be Teachable** – Receive feedback with humility and be eager to grow.

## Saturday Night Flow (Responsibilities)

### Pre-Service (4:50p – 5:25p)

- **Arrive early** to help set up and pray over the space. (*Pick up your name tag, making sure the environment looks good*)
- **Greet students**—especially new or disconnected ones—by name. (*Intentionally seeking out students and getting to know them and their stories, sending them to the Student table in the Worship center to receive all that they need*)
  - This also includes helping get students information to help them connect in our ministry.
- **See the need** - See if there's any areas that need help (*Coffee, Greeters, Information being passed out*)

### Main Service (5:30p – 6:45p)

- Sit with students and engage in worship & teaching.
- Encourage note-taking and Bible use.

- Redirect distractions in a respectful way.

### **Dinner Transition (6:45p – 7:05p)**

- Walk and sit with students who need connection.
- Help students and families know where to go to check in (*Back of the Worship Center, and then down the hallway to grab food*)
- Make sure that students are sitting with other students

### **Connect Groups (7:15p – 8:00p)**

- Help Students get into their groups to start conversations
- Be the one to help lead the conversations in group
- Be ready on occasion to make announcements, do recap, lead through games

### **Wrap-Up (8:00p – 8:15p)**

- Help clean up and follow up with new students, asking them how group went, and exchanging numbers
- Share prayer requests or concerns with the adult leader.

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## **Weekly Commitments**

- Pray for students in your Connect Group by name.
- Check in with at least 1–2 students during the week.
- Invite and encourage friends to come to Saturday night.
- Continue personal Bible reading and prayer.
